### Important info for success with pansies and violas

#### \*\*Pansy and Viola Fertilization is DIFFERENT from Summer Flowers\*\*

Because they are trying to grow in cooler air and soil temps, pansies and violas need a different type of fertilizer than summer flowers. During the cooler/ cold, often-wet weather of our winters and early spring, the warm-season soil bacteria, which convert the ammoniacal and urea nitrogen in fertilizer to the nitrate form that pansies and violas can eat, are dormant. Since the nitogen conversion doesn't happen, if you apply fert with high urea and ammonium nitogen, not only can the pansies starve, but there can be a toxic buildup of ammonia in the soil as well. While it's ok to use summer fertilizers in the early, warm part of fall, it's still best to avoid high levels of ammonia and urea because they may cause to stretch in early fall heat and be more sensitive to frosts. AVOID USING 20-20-20 ON FLOWERS for this reason. Look for half ammoniacal and half nitrate (approx) in the "Guaranteed Analysis" chart on the fertilizer bag. If you can't find it from your usual supplier, we have it for sale here at the nursery.

Apply nitrate-based fertilizers approx every 3 weeks during the winter to keep plants healthy.
